- Meets all of the scholarship criteria defined by the chamber, DELETE which includes proficient academic performance and pursuit of a certificate, license, two year degree or four year degree

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Criteria

Recipient(s) of the WCCCC scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Be a senior student in good standing in his/her high school
- Demonstrate proficient academic achievement, specifically a 2.0 or greater cumulative GPA AND a 2.5 or greater GPA in technical courses
- 3. Achieve an advanced score on the NOCTI
- Demonstrate involvement in school activities and/or community service OR demonstrate active membership in a Career and Technical Service Organization (CTSO, see examples below) OR participate in COOP

Examples of CTSOs, but not limited to

- * DECA
- * FBLA (Future Business Leaders of America)
- * FFA
- * TSA (Technology Student Association)
- * SkillsUSA
- Be accepted at a university, college, community college, or accredited vocational, trade, or business school OR require purchase of tools for the applicant's chosen trade
- 6. Provide a recommendation by an administrator, teacher, coach or other professional reference

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Application Process

- 1. Applications may be obtained online at the Western Chester County Chamber of Commerce website, www.westernchestercounty.com, or in the guidance offices of the following high schools:
 - · Octorara Area Senior High
 - TCHS Brandywine
- Applications must be submitted to the Western Chester County Chamber of Commerce by May 15th of the student's senior year. Applications may be submitted in person, by email at chamber@westernchestercounty.com, or by mail at 50 S First Avenue, Coatesville, PA 19320
- 3. Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Selection Committee, which is comprised of members of the Western Chester County Chamber of Commerce and appointed by the Board of Directors. Recipient(s) will be notified upon verification of the application criteria.
- 4. Scholarship recipients will be recognized at a Western Chester County Chamber of Commerce Event.

Distribution of Scholarships

A check for the full amount of the scholarship will be issued to the school or vendor OR in the name of the recipient upon receipt of a copy of the paid tuition statement from the school or paid purchase receipt from the vendor. Funds may be utilized for reimbursement of tuition payments or purchase of tools for the trade.
